Education/Benefits of admission: Cadets at the service academies are currently entitled to basic pay in the amount of \$600.00 per month. Cadets are also entitled to a basic allowance for subsistence of \$4.60 per day, which is used for food served at the Cadet Dining Hall. Medical and dental care are provided at no expense to cadets. Your pay is considered sufficient for you to be self-supporting, provided you are economical. You will accept an appointment and serve as a commissioned officer in the Air Force for at least eight years after graduation – five of which must be active duty and the remainder can be served as inactive reserve. You become eligible to request a separation from the Air Force after five years of service.
